Major Works planned for John Aird Court (Project Y107) - Update

Following the introductory meeting held in September 2022 regarding the planned major works, I am writing to give you an update as to what has been happening and the next steps.

Following the meeting, our Asset Strategy team have carried out further surveys to assess the works required. They have also carried out a detailed budget review to reflect the rising market prices to ensure we allocate a sufficient budget for these works.

This process is now complete, and the final Client Brief has now been passed to our contractor Axis to start the more detailed planning for the works. Resident update meeting:

Windows working group

Following the introductory meeting in September, we set up a windows working group for John Aird Court which gives residents the opportunity to work with us to look at the design options for the new windows.

The group will be working with Westminster and our contractor Axis to consider a range of window options, however final design options will be put to all residents prior to submitting an application for planning approval.

The group will be meeting with Axis in April to start looking at possible options. There is still space on the working group for additional members, so if any other resident wishes to be part of the working group, please get in touch.
