### Works Update

**Ventilation Works** - The dismantle and rebuild of the existing ventilation plant at **Semley House** has progressed further this month, with a new air handling unit for the block scheduled for installation on the 30th July 2022.

Installation of fire dampers to Brunswick and Dalkeith Courts are ongoing.

United Living continue to try and gain access to individual properties in order to survey existing ventilation arrangements within your properties. We would appreciate your cooperation in allowing us access to your home for these surveys/works to be carried out. Please contact Sadie as soon as possible.

Front entrance door: Hide Tower only (Recertification works): Our United Living team continue these works across the major works project.

**Communal doors**: The communal double doors that service the corridors in **Brunswick and Dalkeith Courts** have been highlighted for review where residents of the blocks have raised concern with excess noise, caused when the doors are opened and or closed. To remedy this, United Living has engaged with the door manufacturer in order to resolve this issue.

We have also installed further kick plates to reduce the damage caused by deliveries within the blocks.

**Basement Plant rooms (Brunswick and Dalkeith Courts)** The new lighting has been reviewed by United Living's Electrical Contractor. We are awaiting a start date to fulfil these works. This is in addition to our initial works.

**Communal Decorations (Brunswick and Dalkeith Courts**): Works to the communal corridors have been completed.
