Sullivan House roof replacement (project AC111)

We are writing to tell you that our contractor, United Living, has been appointed to carry out roof replacement works at Sullivan House in 2021.

The existing roof has suffered from leaks and has historically been patch repaired. However, testing has shown the roof is now beyond economical repair.

What work is planned?

The proposed work includes the full removal of the current roof and installation of the new roof, plus any other associated external repairs. The replacement roof will be guaranteed for 25 years.

What are the next steps?
