Works Update

Brunswick Court: There are three corridor doors left to be fitted and one high level screen. This work is ongoing.

Hide Tower: 24 front entrance doors remain to be fitted. These doors have been manufactured and delivered to site. We will be in touch shortly, in order to make an appointment to install the doors.

Brunswick Court, Dalkeith Court and Hide Tower: We continue to work on a design solution, behind the scenes, to carry out the planned ventilation works to these blocks.

We do apologise for the delay and will update you as soon as we have a definitive start date.

Semley House:

Approximately 60% of door installations are complete and the making good ongoing.

The remainder of the front entrance doors have been manufactured and were delivered to site recently.



We will be in touch soon to make an appointment for the installation of your door.

Floor and Ceiling surveys are ongoing in readiness for works to start later in the year. We will keep you updated.
