NEW CONTRACTOR AT ADPAR STREET DEVELOPMENT

Welcome back to Adpar Street news, keeping you up to date with what's happening with the development and around the neighbourhood. Geoffrey Osborne Construction Limited (Osborne), who were the building contractors several of our affordable housing projects entered administration on the 30 April 2024. Our focus remains on meeting the needs of residents, and we're delivering our planned affordable housing projects with minimal disruption or delay, and we remain committed to completing all of our schemes as planned.

We are pleased to confirm that experienced building contractor Willmott Dixon have been appointed to undertake initial works. This will include work on the hoardings, installation of a temporary welfare cabin, maintenance of the construction sites/buildings, surveys and validation of the works to date along with the production of a programme of works required to complete the projects over the coming months. A decision on whether Willmott Dixon will carry out the remaining construction work will be made over the course of the Summer.

TEMPORARY WELFARE PORTA CABIN AND SURVEYS

This month, Willmott Dixon will place a temporary welfare cabin inside the existing site in Hall Place. This single story cabin will enable Willmott Dixon staff to carry out necessary surveys and inspections. This help us to determine the full scope of works required to reach completion of the scheme. We will provide an update once the completion works are commenced.
