## TOWN AND COUNTRY PLANNING ACT 1971

# TOWN AND COUNTRY FLANNING GENERAL DEVELOPMENT ORDERS 1975 TO 1974

#### WHEREAS:

- (1) The Lord Mayor Aldermen and Citizens of the City of Westminster acting by the Council of the City of Westminster (hereinafter called "the Council") being the local planning authority for the City of Westminster are satisfied that it is expedient in relation to an area of land comprising Nos. 1-27 (inclusive) Bridstow Place W2 in the City of Westminster shown edged red on the annexed plan (hereinafter called "the said area") that any development of the description set out in the Schedule hereto should not be carried out in the said area unless permission therefor is granted on an application made in that behalf under the Town and Country Planning Act 1971
- (2) The Council is satisfied that development in the said area of the description set out in the Schedule hereto would constitute a threat to the amenities of its area

#### NOW THEREFORE:

- 1. The Council in pursuance of the powers conferred on it by Articles4(1) and (3)(b) of the Town and Country Flanning General Development Order 1973 as amended by the Town and Country Flanning General Development (Amendment) Order 1974 (hereinafter called "the said Order") and all other powers / C enabling hereby directs that the permission granted by paragraph (1) of Article 3 of the said Order and the First Schedule thereto shall not apply to development in the said area of the description set out in the Schedule hereto
- 2. By virtue of proviso (i) to Article 4(3) of the Order the Direction herein contained shall remain in force for a period of six months from the date hereof and shall then expire unless it has before the termination of the said six months been approved by the Secretary of State for the Environment

### THE SCHEDULE referred to

Development within the curtilage of a dwelling house being development comprised within the provisions of Class I of the First Schedule to the said Order

Sundry minor operations being development comprised within the provisions of Paragraph 1 of Class II of the First Schedule to the said Order and not being development comprised within anyother Class.
