granted on application made under the Town and
Country Planning General Development Order 1977

AND WHEREAS the Council are further of the opinion that development of the said description would constitute a threat to the amenities of their area and that the provisions of paragraph 3(b) of the said article 4 should apply to this direction

NOW THEREFORE the said Council in pursuance of the powers conferred upon them by the said article 4 hereby direct that the permission granted by article 3 of the Town and Country Planning General Development Order 1977 shall not apply to development on the said land of the description set out in the Schedule hereto

THIS DIRECTION is made in pursuance of the provisions of paragraph (3)(b) of the said article 4 and shall remain in force until 24 free 1981 (being six months from the date of this direction) and will then expire unless it has been approved by the Secretary of State for the Environment before that date

- I. Development within the curtilage of a dwellinghouse, namely:-
 - 1. The enlargement, improvement or other alteration of a dwellinghouse
 - 2. The erection or construction of a porch outside any exterior door of a dwellinghouse
 - 3. The erection, construction or placing, and the maintenance, improvement or other alteration within the curtilage of a dwellinghouse of any building or enclosure required for a purpose incidental to the enjoyment of a dwellinghouse
 - 4. The construction within the qurtilage of a dwellinghouse of a hardstanding for vehicles

being development comprised within paragraphs 1, 2, 3 and 4 of Class 1 referred to in Schedule 1 of the said order, and

- II Sundry minor operations namely :-
 - The erection or construction of gates,
 fences, walls or other means of enclosure
 - 2. The formation, laying out and construction of a means of access to the highway
 - 3. The painting of the exterior of any building being development comprised within paragraphs 1, 2 and 3 of Class II referred to in Schedule 1 of the said order


