# Schedule of changes to adopted policies

The Partial Review introduces five new policies to Westminster’s City Plan 2019-2040 (2021). As consulted under Regulation 19 (see document CORE\_001), these are policies:

- **Policy 8** St Mary’s Hospital
- **Policy 9** Westbourne Park Bus Garage
- **Policy 10** Land adjacent to Royal Oak
- **Policy 11** Grosvenor Sidings
- **Policy 43** Retrofit first

These policies do not supersede any adopted policies.

The Partial Review also proposes a new affordable housing policy is adopted, and that it replaces the adopted one as shown in Table 1.

All the changes above mean most City Plan 2019-2040 (2021) policies will need to be renumbered if the six new policies are confirmed through the Examination in Public.

During consultation under Regulation 19, the council also recommended other minor incidental changes to the adopted plan or factual updates. Table 2 shows which sections will be superseded should the proposed changes go ahead.
