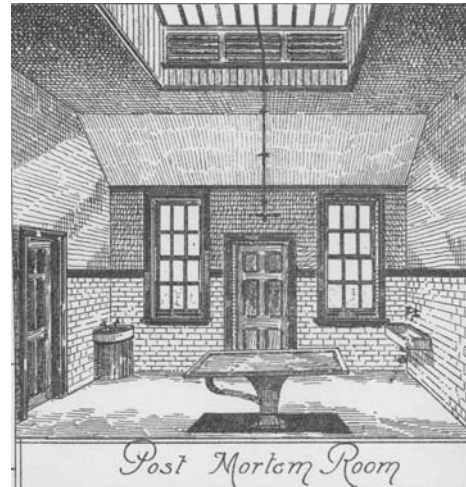
St Marylebone
