### WHAT'S NEW AT PARSONS NORTH

Westminster City Council and Osborne took an afternoon away from their busy construction schedule on 21 August to celebrate the completion of enabling works and the ceremonial 'first spade in the ground' as digging of the foundations for Parsons North begins.

The ceremony was attended by the Little Venice ward councillors, Councillor Caplan, Councillor Green and Councillor Dean. and the joint project team. Proceedings were led by Councillor Rachael Robathan, Cabinet Member for Finance, Property and Regeneration and Andrew Osborne, Chief Executive of Osborne.

The formalities took place on site with a presentation of an engraved spade by Andrew Osborne, MD of Osborne, and Cllr Robathan had the opportunity to fire up the digger and 'break ground'.

With construction of the new building at Parsons North now underway, you can expect to see the following milestones in the coming months:

- ► Completion of the pile foundations by the end of September 2019
- ► Completion of the basement concrete slab by December 2019
- ▶ Drainage works to be complete by November 2019
- ▶ Erection of the Tower Crane in early December 2019
