Our focus remains on meeting the needs of residents, and we're delivering our planned affordable housing projects with minimal disruption or delay, and we remain committed to completing all of our schemes

as planned. We are pleased to confirm that experienced building contractor Willmott Dixon have been appointed to undertake initial works across the three projects.

This will include work on the hoardings, maintenance of the construction sites/buildings and production of a programme of works required to complete the projects over the coming months. A decision on whether Willmott Dixon will carry out the remaining construction work will be made in the Summer.
