e met Mr Ali and his family who have been on the housing waiting list for over a decade. They were delighted to be housed in an adapted flat which means it can meet the needs of their

family and their elderly disabled mother. Both Mr Ali and his wife are carers for Sabeeha – Al who needs additional support on a daily basis.


Mr Ali and his family are originally from Kurdish Iraq and were displaced due to war. They took refuge in the UK and were living in a small twobedroom flat with their four children.

Mr Ali said:

I can't tell you how happy I am, honestly I can't! Moving into this new flat is a lifeline for us, an opportunity to start all over again as a family. Mentally we are all a lot happier. Finally, my son has a bed and he no longer has to sleep on the floor. The space allows us to breathe, and there's room for each family member. It's not just a home; it's a symbol of hope, prosperity and a fresh start. This new home will transform our lives and I am looking forward to my children growing up much healthier and happier.


Ms Sabeeha – Al said:


NEW PUBLIC PLAYGROUND AND LANDSCAPED AREAS


